President's Letter 2018

We warmly thank you for supporting us during our 117th season. In 1901 we began with 10 campers and have now grown to welcoming 150 campers for a traditional sleep-away experience. Our year-round off-season programs serve over 200 campers, alumni and their families. We celebrate you for your generous donations that have made this growth and longevity possible.

The summer of 2018 was one that our campers and staff will never forget. The completion of our new Main Building happened on time and marked the end of our five-year plan to upgrade our facilities. Our goal was to ensure that the unique physical challenges that our children face would be met by designing a wheel chair friendly building that was fully accessible and unrestricted. The open plan and air-conditioned dining area provided increased freedom for independent social interaction. The new building also includes a commercial kitchen, staff living quarters, and a spacious shaded deck, which became a popular and safe space for games, dances and friend time.

Another milestone was realized this year with the addition of our new solar power system. Thanks to the generosity of an anonymous donor, we installed over 170 panels on six roofs throughout our campus. Our goal of becoming more environmentally sustainable has been achieved as evidenced by our greatly reduced electrical bills.

Our children can't get enough of our off-season expanded programs that include Life Skill Lab workshops, recreational fall and spring weekends at the camp, trips to sporting events, concerts, the theatre, adaptive skiing trips, college tours, workshops on on-line resources, a special needs equipment exchange and an educational Spring Symposium.


We are blessed to have many organizations partnering with us to provide special activities for our campers including the Southampton Animal Shelter, North Sea Fireman's Carnival, Southampton Arts Center, Parrish Art Museum, Southfork Natural History Museum, Southampton Cultural Center, the Innovators Camp, Kiwanis Club of Southampton, NY Mets, Breakers and Long Island Ducks baseball teams and the Southampton Rotarians.

Our two annual fund raising events, the Decorators-Designers-Dealers Sale and Auction Gala and the American Picnic with Fireworks, along with generous grants from private foundations and donors have enabled us to offer these programs without regard to each family's ability to pay.

Over the past two years it has been my privilege to serve as President and I have enjoyed my interaction with our campers and families as I learned about their daily challenges. A member of our advisory board, Yvette Tibbs recently told me that the reason her daughter Tyler, a 10 year camp alumna will soon graduate from college is because of the confidence and independence skills that she learned during her summers at our camp. Our mission is an important one and I know that Sarah Senbahar, our new Board President will provide strong leadership after her many years of dedication to the Southampton Fresh Air Home.

We are committed to providing our special youth with life enhancing experiences. Thank you for being a part of this extraordinary and generous community that has sustained our family-oriented organization for over 100 years. We look forward to a bright future ensuring that Kids+ Camp= Joy!

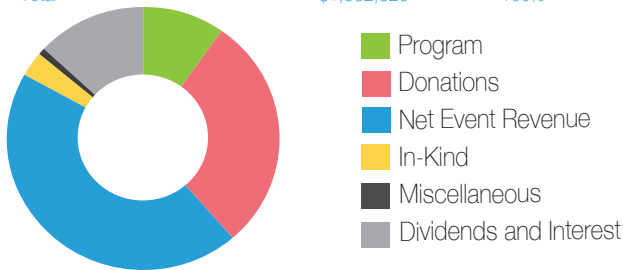
Dedication of newly renovated Main Building.

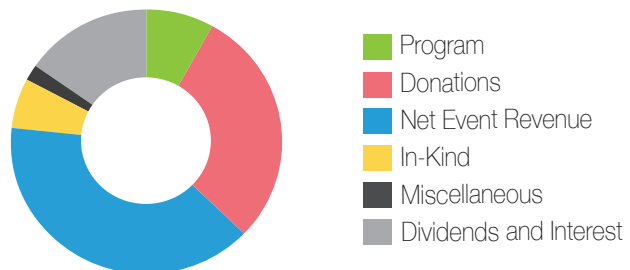
Actual 2017 Operating Income

Actual 2018 Operating Income

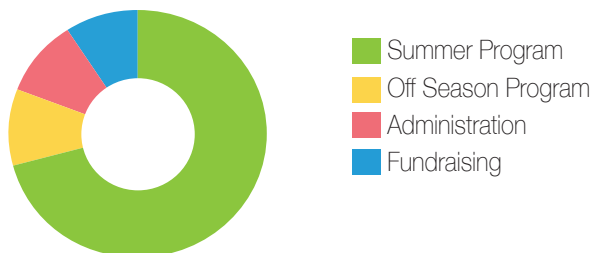

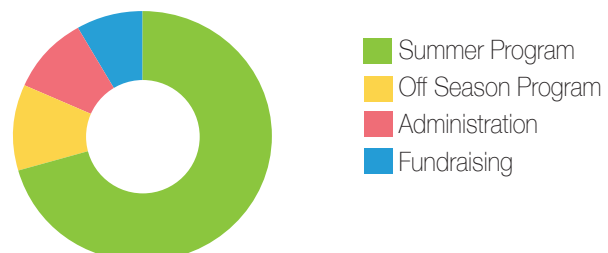
Net operating income/(deficit)* \$(366,896)

While our summer camp program is a successful one, our youth have expressed a lack of recreational opportunities during the year. SFAH has addressed the needs through a program expansion that furthers our goals through an innovative model serving both current campers, ages 8-18 and young adult "alumni" who have aged out of the summer camp program, but still need support as they transition into adulthood.

One important component added to our year-round programs has been Life Skill Labs. Life Skill Labs are a program designed to inform, educate and guide our campers and alumni through various areas of independent living and daily functioning. In consultation with a team of occupational therapists, special education teachers and other professionals, this program has purposeful and enjoyable activities specific to our camper needs.

In 2018, we hosted five Life Skill Lab workshops which enabled current and alumni campers to gain more independence and confidence in everyday areas. We focused on independent living skills, learning basic first aid and self-advocacy, and visited two disability fairs which encouraged our campers to seek alternative resources in the community.

These program expansions have allowed SFAH to move from a "summer+" model to a year-round resource for youth with physical disabilities.

Capital Campaign

Over our 117-year history, the four-acre campus at 36 Barkers Island Road has seen a tremendous evolution. Thanks to the addition of climate controlled dormitories built in 2008, the SFAH began offering occasional off-season weekend retreats for current campers and alumni. In 2018, we offered over 40 off-season offerings directly addressing the needs of our population. These included Life Skill Lab workshops, respite weekends, day trips, equipment exchanges, college tours and social media groups.

In 2013, a further modernization of our campus was deemed necessary so as to better serve our physically challenged children and their ever more complex needs in the best possible way. A five-year renovation plan began and was initially sustained by individual bequests, the Home's endowment, and foundation and private grants. In 2015, the Board initiated a Capital Campaign to raise the additional funds to complete these projects.

Projects include our new administrative building, a renovation of the pools and sports courts, shade awnings, upgrade of the transportation fleet, addition of a solar power system, and full renovation of the Home's Main Building, which includes the dining hall, commercial kitchen and staff residences.

Mrs. Meszkat remembers trying to make the facility look better by adding flowers, but the soil was so rough that she could not get them into the ground.

The next year, Christl was asked to help with the D-D-D event set up. She volunteered to help with the silent auction, and then started working on pricing with Linda Beck. But it was meeting the campers that truly drew Christl to the Fresh Air Home.

"We had a small group of children go to the driving range and the camp director asked me to help. I was so taken by it and amazed by what they could do. There was a child with no arms who was able to do much for himself. From that point on, I offered to come up to the Home and volunteer whenever I could." 20 years later, Christl is still helping with the golf, which now takes place each year at Shinnecock Hills Golf Club. "It is a very special experience for the campers."

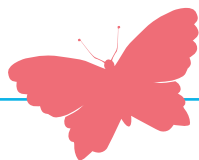
